

1. Molding techniques

In this step we will create a mold to accommodate the plaster

- a) Add 30cl of cold water to the bucket.
- b) Add the alginate powder ("BAG ETAPE 1") in cold water and mix quickly until a smooth and homogeneous "pink" color is obtained.
- c) Immerse your baby's hand in the mold pot and stay still for a few minutes until the alginate is gelled and gray in color.

We recommend doing this step when he is calm or asleep to prevent him from moving.

You can then gently take out your hand, being careful not to damage the mold.

2. Casting plaster

- a) Pour into a salad bowl 20cl to 25cl of water and sprinkle the casting plaster (SACHET ETAPE 2)
- b) Let rest for 30 seconds the plaster mixture
- c) Put the plastic gloves provided in the kit and mix the plaster until a liquid and creamy mixture is obtained.
- d) Leave the plaster mixture to rest for 15 seconds to let the air bubbles escape.
- e) Then pour the plaster into the mold gently by moving the bucket so that the cast plaster fills all cavities.

Let it dry for at least 30 minutes to be able to unmold

3. After drying, demolding

When the cast plaster is dry, turn the bucket over and gently remove the alginate from the solidified plaster using a small blade (cutter, knife) being careful not to damage the sculpture with the blade. Correct the Defaults with a thin knife Let dry another 24 hours if you want to paint it.

We recommend applying an acrylic spray paint available in DIY stores, Gold, Silver or Bronze colors will bring the most beautiful effect.
